

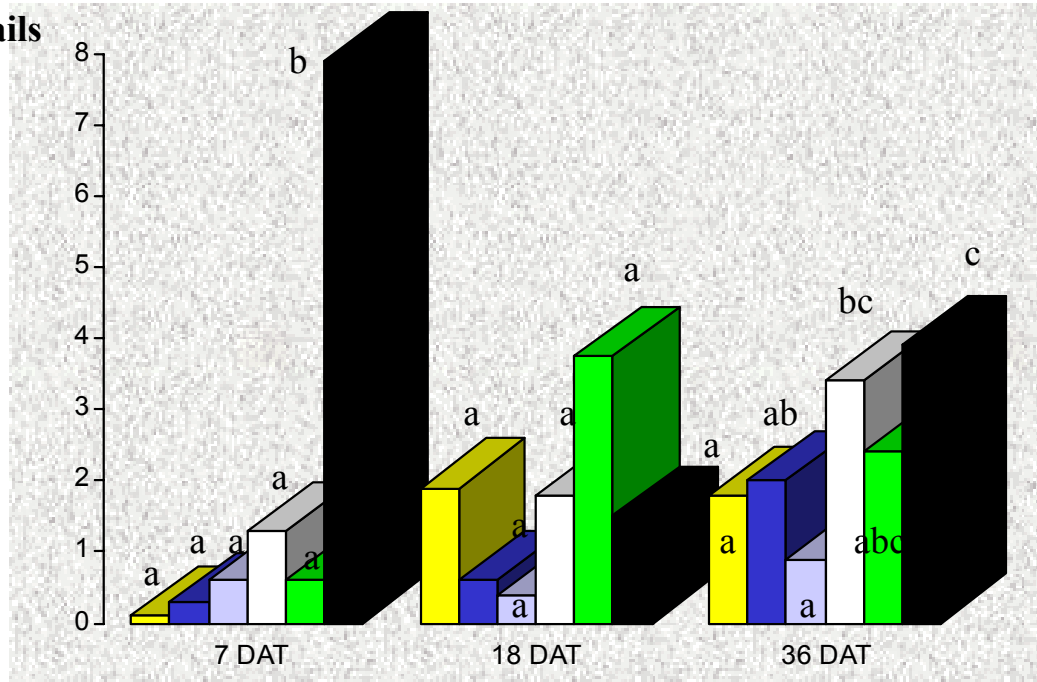
Gray Garden Slug Control in Grass Seed Crop

Glenn Fisher notes that none of the treatments were statistically different. Weather played a big factor throughout the trial. The first 10 days had high dew points and slugs were active on the soil surface. Dry, cold and somewhat windy conditions prevailed afterwards and through the 30th day. A few nights allowed slug activity, but activity was minimal. *“To summarize, I believe the 7 day evaluation was most telling for all baits tested”*, states Fisher.
